Simplified overview of codicological analysis with regards to production units (acc. to Andrist et al. 2013) by Lea D. Pokorny and Beeke Stegmann.\*

Result: There are at least four production units from the late 14th century: PU1: ff. 1-12, 28-29; PU2: ff. 15-27; PU3: f. 13; PU4: f. 14. Given the homogenous nature of the mise-en-page and the art-historical assessment of Guðbjörg Kristjánsdóttir (forthcomming), PU2 was likely added onto PU1 and some of the illumination and rubrication work on the leaves of PU1 was carried out then (yellow). It can, however, not be ruled out that the highlighted rubrics and/or illuminations form their own, separate PU (PU5).
